



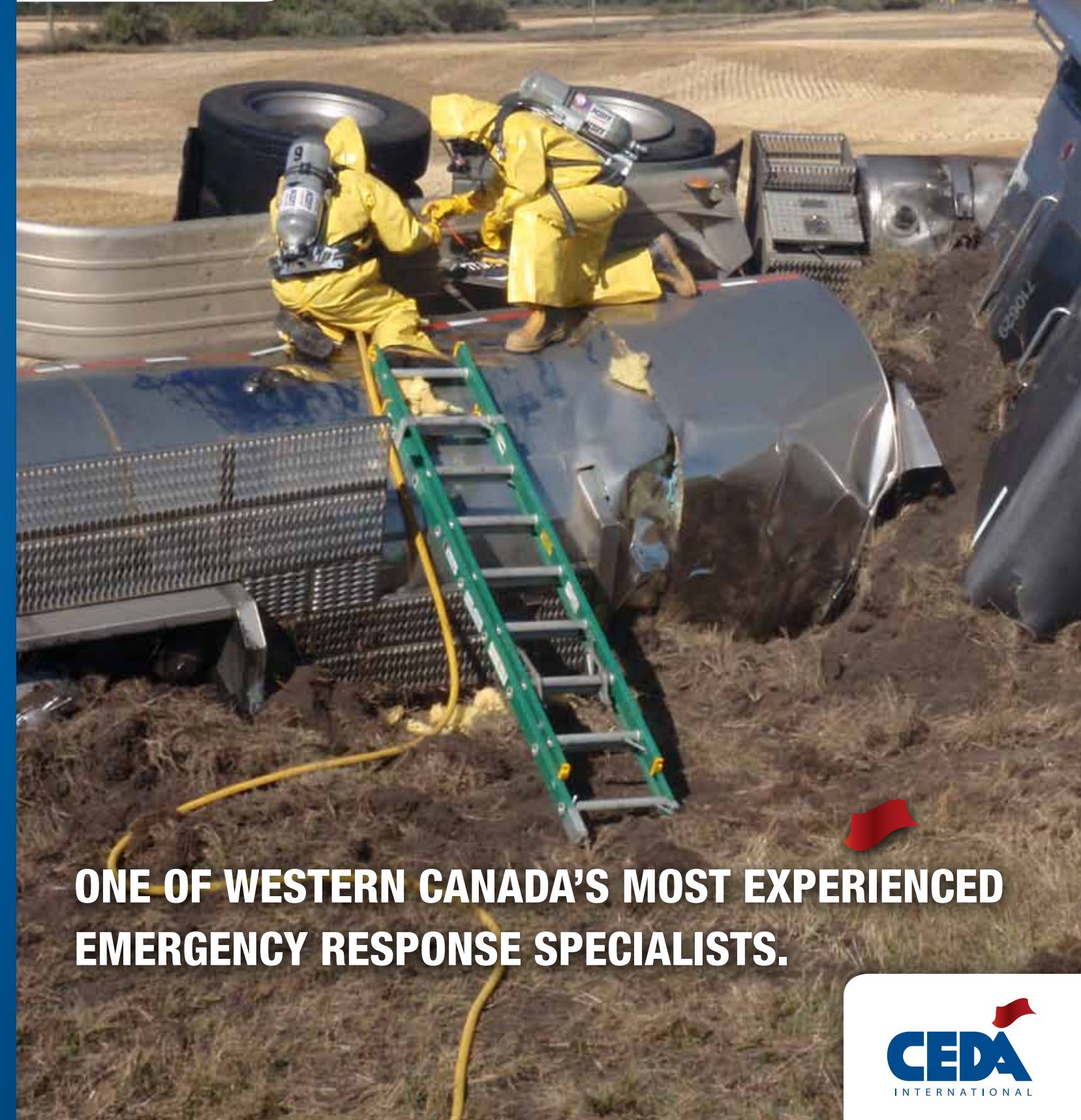

These emergencies range from tank truck rollovers, multi-railcar derailments and unknown chemical spills. CERT is a member of The Canadian Emergency Response Contractors Alliance (CERCA). As a verified emergency response service provider, CERT's highly trained specialists are capable of responding to all nine classes of dangerous goods including unstable and explosive chemicals and bio-hazardous waste.

## HIGHLY TRAINED SPECIALISTS

CERT specialists are certified to respond to all nine classes of dangerous goods and associated wastes. CERT technicians are trained in all levels of personal protective equipment from Level A to Level D as well as the use of respirators and self contained breathing apparatus (SCBA).
